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# Safety Message to Installers of Warning Light Equipment A WARNING

People's lives depend on your proper installation and servicing of Federal Signal products. It is important to read and follow all instructions shipped with this product and the original product. In addition, listed below are some other important safety instructions and precautions you should follow:

- To properly install the lighting system, you must have a good understanding of automotive systems, along with proficiency in the installation and use of safety warning equipment.
- Do not install equipment or route wiring in the deployment path of an airbag.
- If a vehicle seat is temporarily removed, verify with the vehicle manufacturer if the seat needs to be recalibrated for proper airbag deployment.
- You should frequently inspect the light system to ensure that it is operating properly and that it is securely attached to the vehicle.
- When drilling into a vehicle structure, be sure that both sides of the surface are clear of anything that could be damaged.
- Refer to the instructions packed with related products for additional precautions and information.
- File these instructions in a safe place and refer to them when maintaining and/or reinstalling the product.
- Do not stare directly into the lights at a close range or permanent damage to your eyesight may occur.

Failure to follow all safety precautions and instructions may result in property damage, serious injury, or death.

#### **Unpacking the Kit**

After unpacking the product, inspect it for damage that may have occurred in transit. If it has been damaged or is missing a part, do not attempt to install or operate it. File a claim immediately with the carrier, stating the extent of the damage. Carefully check all envelopes, shipping labels and tags before removing or destroying them. Ensure that all parts in Table 1 have been included. If you are missing any parts, contact Customer Support at 1-800-264-3578, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday (CT).

#### Introduction

This publication has instructions for using the MSPM6-LPV1 Adjustable License Plate Mounting Kit to mount the MPS600U lighthead to the license plate area of many vehicles. The assembled unit is 6 inches high by 18-3/4 inches wide.

**NOTE:** For electrical installation instructions, refer to the Installation and Maintenance Instructions packed with the lighthead.



#### Installing the Kit

### **A** WARNING

AIRBAG DEPLOYMENT — Do not install or route wiring in the deployment path of an airbag. Failure to observe this warning will reduce the effectiveness of the airbag or potentially dislodge the equipment, causing serious injury or death.

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#### **NOTICE**

DRILLING PRECAUTIONS — Before drilling holes, check the area you are drilling into to be sure you do not damage vehicle components. All drilled holes should be de-burred and all sharp edges should be smoothed. All wire routings going through drilled holes should be protected by a grommet or convolute/split loom tubing.

#### **NOTICE**

THREAD DAMAGE AND GALLING — To prevent thread damage and galling, anti-seize must be used on all stainless steel fasteners.

**IMPORTANT:** Plan all cable routing before the installation.

To mount the bracket:

- 1. Remove the license plate mounting hardware, license plate, and bracket from the front of the vehicle.
- **2.** Mount the hat bracket to the vehicle with the factory license plate hardware removed in Step 1. For the most secure mounting, install hardware at all four positions.
- **3.** Loosely assemble the MPS mounting brackets to the license plate bracket with the six 8-32 pan-head screws.
- **4.** Hold the assembly to the hat bracket and adjust the MPS brackets to the desired angle, then tighten the screws. Do not over-tighten.
- **5.** Attach the lightheads to the brackets.
  - ▶ Use the 6-32 screws and Keps nuts included with the kit.
- **6.** Secure the assembly to the hat bracket with the four #10 flat-head screws.
- 7. Mount the license plate with the supplied 1/4 inch screws, washers, and lockwashers.

**8.** Test the lights for proper operation.
