- Do not install equipment or route wiring in the deployment path of an airbag.
- If a vehicle seat is temporarily removed, verify with the vehicle manufacturer if the seat needs to be recalibrated for proper airbag deployment.
- When drilling into a vehicle structure, ensure that both sides of the surface are clear of anything that could be damaged.
- Locate the light control so the VEHICLE and CONTROL can be operated safely under all driving conditions.
- Do not attempt to activate or deactivate the light control while driving in a hazardous situation.
- Frequently inspect the light to ensure that it is operating properly and that it is securely attached to the vehicle.
- This product contains high intensity LEDs. Do not stare directly into the lights at a close range or permanent damage to your eyesight may occur.
- Refer to the instructions packed with related products for additional precautions and information.
- File these instructions in a safe place and refer to them when maintaining and/or reinstalling the product.

Failure to follow all safety precautions and instructions may result in property damage, serious injury, or death.

Installing the MPSM6-TA21RS1 Mounting Bracket Kit

AWARNING

IMPORTANT: Plan all cable routing before the installation.

To install the mounting bracket kit:

- 1. Following the vehicle manufacturer instructions, remove the rear spoiler assembly.





Figure 1 Bracket positioning

- 2. With the upper and lower spoiler still assembled, position the brackets as shown, and mark the four mounting holes. See Figure 1.

DRILLING PRECAUTIONS: When drilling holes, check the area you are drilling into to ensure that you do not damage vehicle components. All drilled holes should be deburred and all sharp edges should be smoothed. All wire routings going through drilled holes should be protected by a grommet or convolute/split loom tubing.

- 3. With a 3/16-inch drill, drill the mounting holes through both layers (approximately 1/2 inch deep).
- 4. If you are routing wiring between the upper and lower spoiler, remove the lower spoiler, drill the appropriate access holes and route and dress wires, then reinstall the lower spoiler.
- 5. Mount the brackets with 1/4-inch hex head screws and 1/4-inch lockwashers.
- 6. Install the light heads (not included) to both brackets with the supplied 6-32 screws and Keps_® nuts.
- 7. Reinstall the spoiler.
- 8. Complete the wiring per the instructions supplied with the light heads.

9. Install the cover plates with the black 8-32 thread-forming screws. See Figure 2.
